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Overcoming chronic illness and ulcerative colitis, Mark has carved a niche as an innovative cinematographer whose visual storytelling power has earned accolades across film, TV, and interactive media. His award-winning work spans feature films such as *Lightships, Election Night, Armageddon Gospels*, and *There's No Such Thing as Zombies*, with standout nominations for Best Cinematography on the music promo *Judge Me* and the experimental short *Intruder*. Most recently, he brought his signature style to the groundbreaking FMV game *Equinox*, directed by Craig Griffith and featuring cult actor and writer Rupert Booth, set within the imaginative realms of Booth's Protoverse universe. In addition to his dynamic creative practice, Mark is a doctoral researcher and associate lecturer at Goldsmiths, University of London. His cutting-edge research explores the health and mental well-being of film and TV professionals in the UK, shedding light on the psychological

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challenges and resilience factors within the creative industries. Whether behind the camera or in the lecture hall, Mark's work is a testament to the transformative power of storytelling and creative innovation.

BRIEF BIOGRAPHY

While studying engineering at university in the late 1990s, Mark became involved with UCL Film Society (former pres. **Christopher Nolan**), which led to a lifelong passion in filmmaking. After university he attended prestigious **Met Film School, Ealing Studios** for its one-year practical film-making course. While there, he was in part taught by **Paul Wheeler BSC** who introduced him to working within professional camera departments and by the end of 2006, was working fully professionally in camera/lighting. In recent years Mark has become increasingly involved with women's rights campaigns and is a big supporter of women in film.
